

UIL Eligibility Calendar 2017-2018
San Angelo Independent School District

- **August 17, 2017** – First day of school
- **September 29, 2017** – End of first six weeks. First official grade check for students
- **October 6, 2017** – End of 7 day grace period. Students gain/lose eligibility at the end of the school day
- **October 13, 2017** – End of 1st nine weeks. Grade check for all students. If passing, they are eligible for the next 9 weeks
- **October 20, 2017** – End of 7 day grace period. Students gain/lose eligibility at the end of the school day
- **November 3, 2017** – 3 week grade check. Students must be passing all classes to regain eligibility
- **November 10, 2017** – Ineligible students regain eligibility at the end of the school day
- **November 21, 2017** – 3 week grade check. Students must be passing all classes to be eligible
- **November 28, 2017** – Ineligible students regain eligibility at the end of the school day
- **December 15, 2017** - End of 2nd nine weeks. Grade check for all students. If passing, they are eligible for the next 9 weeks
- **December 18, 2017 – January 2, 2018** – Christmas Break. All students passing or failing are academically eligible
- **January 10, 2018** – End of 7 day grace period. Students gain/lose eligibility at the end of the school day
- **January 22, 2018** - 3 week grade check. Students must be passing all classes to be eligible
- **January 29, 2018** - Ineligible students regain eligibility at the end of the school day
- **February 12, 2018** - 3 week grade check. Students must be passing all classes to be eligible
- **February 19, 2018** - Ineligible students regain eligibility at the end of the school day
- **March 9, 2018** - - End of 3rd nine weeks. Grade check for all students. If passing, they are eligible for the next 9 weeks

- **March 12-18, 2018** – Spring Break – all students passing or failing are academically eligible
 - **March 26, 2018 - End of 7 day grace period.** Students gain/lose eligibility at the end of the school day
 - **April 6, 2018** - 3 week grade check. Students must be passing all classes to be eligible
 - **April 13, 2018** - Ineligible students regain eligibility at the end of the school day
 - **April 27, 2018** - 3 week grade check. Students must be passing all classes to be eligible
 - **May 4, 2018** - Ineligible students regain eligibility at the end of the school day
 - **May 25, 2018** – End of 4th nine weeks grading period

- **Students may only lose eligibility at the first six weeks and the nine weeks grading period**
- **Students can regain eligibility at the following times: 3 weeks progress report, 6 weeks progress report and nine week grade report**
- **All students are academically eligible during Christmas Break and Spring Break**
- **All students not meeting credit/promotion criteria on August 17, 2017 are academically ineligible until the end of the 1st six weeks**
- **Academic eligibility is determined by nine week grades, not semester grades**
- **A grace period equals 7 calendar days**
- **Total credits from the previous year to determine 2017-2018 first six weeks eligibility for 10th-12th grade students. The second year of high school they must have 5 credits, 3rd year – 10 credits and 4th year – 15 credits. 7-9th grade must have advanced to the next grade in order to be eligible for the first six weeks.**
