1. Required Improvement Performance Objectives – CIP/DIP/CNA

4. Highly Qualified

Our district is 100% highly qualified. A report will be submitted to TEA and to our school board in November.

5. T.A.I.S. Process

The Texas Accountability Intervention System (TAIS) requires one Continuous Improvement Plan at the district level for all areas in need of improvement. This is because many of these students cross into several special populations – ELL's and Special Education.

Our district is required to form a District Leadership Team to write the TAIS Plan. The team members will need to include teachers, administrators, private non-profit school reps, community members, and parents. A plan has to be written before October 31.

The team will identify a strategy and identify root causes.

6. PBMAS Audit

Our District just completed the PBMAS audit with the Texas Education Agency. The auditors were very complimentary of our campuses. The audit went well with a few minor bumps. In ESL/Bilingual there were a couple of forms that didn't have a 2nd signature on a page, and an area where something was checked that shouldn't have been.

The PAR part of the audit involved checking the facilities. There were some toilet and sink handles that had to be replaced, and a few thresholds that will need to be lowered.
