



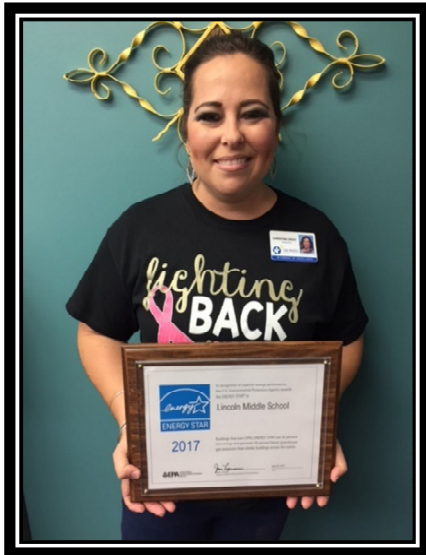

ENERGY STAR comes to SAISD! Every Elementary & Secondary campus earned this prestigious designation as an energy conservation leader for K-12 public schools.



ENERGY STAR began in 1992 with the Environmental Protection Agency and the Department of Energy.

It is the government backed symbol for energy efficiency. 90% of Americans recognize the Energy Star label on new appliances. Now the program has expanded to award businesses, schools, and other buildings for their energy conservation measures. In 2016 Energy Star came to SAISD and evaluated each campus. As a result of your efforts at saving, **EVERY** SAISD student campus is now in the 85th to 99th percentile of K-12 schools for energy efficiency. Thank you SAISD!

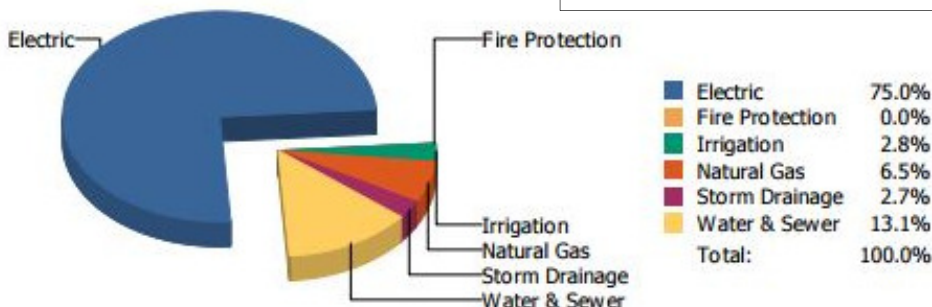

Lighting – by the numbers. Help SAISD save 10%

Do you ever leave your class during lunch? Conference? Turning lights off for empty rooms, gyms, cafeterias - even multiple times a day, is still more efficient than on all day. There are approx. 1,400 classrooms in SAISD, each costing about 90 cents a day in electricity. That's \$235,620 per year! Please don't work in the dark! But trimming a few minutes daily where you can adds up to real savings!

*The chart below shows the district's utility bills by %. The total cost for all SAISD utilities last calendar year was **\$2,658,613** (AC & lighting are the largest cost)*
